

National Health Security Regulations 2008¹

1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *National Health Security Regulations* 2008.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

3 Definition

In these Regulations:

Act means the National Health Security Act 2007.

4 Prescribed intelligence agencies

For paragraph 23 (2) (b) of the Act, each of the following intelligence agencies is prescribed:

- (a) Australian Security Intelligence Organisation;
- (b) Australian Federal Police.
