An Ordinance to amend the *Applied Laws* (*Implementation*) Ordinance 1992 and for related purposes

1 Name of Ordinance

This Ordinance is the Applied Laws (Implementation) Amendment Ordinance 2008 (No. 1).

2 Commencement

This Ordinance commences on 1 July 2008.

3 Amendment of Applied Laws (Implementation) Ordinance 1992

Omit the subparagraphs, substitute:

- (i) is, or becomes, a person to whom a first home owner grant would be, or would have been, payable if section 18 of the FHOG Act applied to the person in relation to the property; or
- (ii) is, or becomes a person to whom a first home owner grant would be, or would have been, payable in relation to the property if consideration had been given for the transfer of the property; and

1.2 Paragraph 142 (2) (a):

Omit the paragraph, substitute:

(a) from a person who would have been excluded from the operation of the FHOG Act section 16 (1); and
