Regulation 1

1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Cross-Border Insolvency Regulations 2008*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence immediately after the commencement of Parts 2, 3 and 4 of the Act.

3 Definitions

In these Regulations:

Act means the *Cross-Border Insolvency Act 2008*.

ADI has the same meaning as in the *Banking Act 1959*.

general insurer has the same meaning as in the *Insurance Act 1973*.

life company has the same meaning as in the *Life Insurance Act 1995*.

4 Prescribed entities (Act s 9)

For section 9 of the Act, the entities listed in Schedule 1 are prescribed entities.
