- 63470 MRI — scan of the pelvis for the staging of histologically 403.20 diagnosed cervical cancer at FIGO stage 1B or greater, if the request for scan identifies that:
  - (a) a histological diagnosis of carcinoma of the cervix has been made; and
  - (b) the patient has been diagnosed with cervical cancer at FIGO stage 1B or greater (R) (Anaes.) (Contrast)
- MRI scan of the pelvis and upper abdomen, in a single 63473 627.20 examination, for the staging of histologically diagnosed cervical cancer at FIGO stage 1B or greater, if the request for scan identifies that:
  - (a) a histological diagnosis of carcinoma of the cervix has been made; and
  - (b) the patient has been diagnosed with cervical cancer at FIGO stage 1B or greater (R) (Anaes.) (Contrast)
- 63476 403.20 MRI — scan of the pelvis for the initial staging of rectal cancer, if:
  - (a) a phased array body coil is used; and
  - (b) the request for scan identifies that the indication is for the initial staging of rectal cancer (including cancer of the rectosigmoid and anorectum) (R) (Anaes.) (Contrast)
