1 Name of Determination

This Determination is the *Aged Care (Residential Care Subsidy – Amount of Oxygen Supplement) Determination 2009 (No. 1)*.

2 Commencement

This Determination commences on 1 July 2009.

3 Revocation

The *Aged Care Act 1997 – Determination under section 44-13* made on 16 June 2008, also known as ACA Ch.3 No.13/2008 and F2008L02229, is revoked.

1 *Aged Care (Residential Care Subsidy — Amount of Oxygen Supplement) Determination 2009 (No. 1)*

4 Amount of Oxygen Supplement

- (1) Subject to subsection (2), the amount of oxygen supplement payable in respect of a day is \$9.51.
- (2) Where the actual cost to the approved provider of administering oxygen to the care recipient is equal to, or more than, 125% of the amount referred to in subsection (1) (i.e. \$11.89), the amount of the oxygen supplement payable in respect of a day is an amount equivalent to that actual cost.
