1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Charter of the United Nations (Sanctions — Democratic People's Republic of Korea) Amendment Regulations 2009 (No. 2)*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

3 Amendment of *Charter of the United Nations (Sanctions — Democratic People's Republic of Korea) Regulations 2008*

Schedule 1 Amendment

(regulation 3)

[1] Subregulation 9 (2)

substitute

- (2) A person contravenes this regulation if:
- (a) the person makes a sanctioned supply; and
 - (b) the sanctioned supply is not an authorised supply.
