1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Health Insurance (Diagnostic Imaging Services Table) Amendment Regulations 2009 (No. 4).*

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence as follows:

- (a) on 9 November 2009 regulations 1 to 3 and Schedule 1;
- (b) on 1 January 2010 Schedule 2.

Schedule 2 Amendment commencing on 1 January 2010

(regulation 3)

[1] Schedule 1, Part 3, item 63464, subparagraph (a) (ii)

substitute

- (ii) 2 or more first or second degree relatives on the same side of the family diagnosed with breast or ovarian cancer, if any of the following applies to at least 1 of the relatives:
 - (A) has been diagnosed with bilateral breast cancer;
 - (B) had onset of breast cancer before the age of 40 years;
 - (C) had onset of ovarian cancer before the age of 50 years;
 - (D) has been diagnosed with breast and ovarian cancer, at the same time or at different times;
 - (E) has Ashkenazi Jewish ancestry;
 - (F) is a male relative who has been diagnosed with breast cancer;
