TEMPORARY ORDER

Fisheries Management (Southern and Eastern Scalefish and Shark Fishery – Variation of Total Allowable Catch) Temporary Order 2009 (No.2)

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Fisheries Management (Southern and Eastern Scalefish and Shark Fishery - Variation of Total Allowable Catch) Temporary Order* 2009 (No.2).

2 Commencement and Cessation

This Order commences at the start of 18 December 2009 and ceases at the end of 30 April 2010.

3 Variation of Total Allowable Catch

- (a) For the fishing year that commenced on 1 May 2009 under the *Southern and Eastern Scalefish and Shark Fishery Management Plan 2003* (the Plan), the total allowable catch (TAC) determined under section 11 of the Plan for the species Deepwater flathead (*Neoplatycephalus conatus*), being Item 27 in Schedule 2 of the Plan, may be varied once.
- (b) Pursuant to paragraph 3(a), the TAC for Deepwater Flathead (*Neoplatycephalus conatus*) that has been determined under section 11 of the Plan for the fishing year that commenced on 1 May 2009 is increased from 1,300 tonnes to 1,400 tonnes.
