1 Name of determination

This determination is the Social Security (Approved Scholarship Courses) Determination 2010 (No. 1).

2 Commencement

This determination commences on 1 April 2010.

3 Definitions

In this determination:

Act means the Social Security Act 1991.

accredited higher education course means a course that is:

- (a) accredited as a higher education course by an authority responsible for the accreditation of higher education courses in a State or Territory; or
- (b) if a higher education institution is authorised by a law of the Commonwealth or a law of the State or Territory in which the institution is located to accredit its own higher education courses a course conducted and accredited as a higher education course by that institution.

higher education institution means:

- (a) an institution that is established by a law of the Commonwealth, a State or a Territory as a higher education institution;
- (b) an institution registered by the relevant State or Territory higher education recognition authority as a higher education institution

preparatory course means a course offered by a higher education institution that is designed to assist people to gain entry to higher education level courses (including enabling and bridging courses).

4 Approved scholarship courses

For subsection 592N (1) of the Act, an approved scholarship course is:

- (a) an accredited higher education course; or
- (b) a preparatory course;

that is undertaken at a higher education institution.
