1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Administration) Amendment Regulations 2010 (No. 2)*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on 1 July 2010.

3 Amendment of *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Administration) Regulations 1995*

(regulation 3)

[1] Subregulation 3.550 (1)

substitute

- (1) Subject to subregulation (2), the following fees are prescribed for subsection 69D (1) of the Act:
- (a) \$125 as the standard fee for a certificate;
 - (b) if the certificate requires technical or scientific assessment to be undertaken by the APVMA, a further \$105 for the assessment.
