**1 Name of Regulations**

These Regulations are the *Proceeds of Crime Amendment Regulations 2010 (No. 1)*.

**2 Commencement**

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

- (iiia) section 73.3A (supporting the offence of people smuggling);
