Part 147 Manual of Standards Amendment Instrument 2011 (No. 2)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Part 147 Manual of Standards Amendment Instrument 2011 (No. 2)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after registration.

3 Amendment of Part 147 Manual of Standards

The Part 147 Manual of Standards is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

Schedule 1 Amendment

[1] Sub-subparagraph 147.A.106 (a) 1. (iii)

(iii) to participate in confirming assessment that meet the current requirements for training and assessment under the Australian Qualifications Framework determined by the National Skills Standards Council, or its successors, in effect at the time of delivery and assessment;

substitute

(a) Within 4 weeks of issuing each certificate under paragraph 147.040 (d) of CASR 1998, an MTO must provide CASA with a report that provides details of the certificate.

omit

confirm to CASR 66.025 criteria for the grant of a licence including:
