1. Name of Determination

This Determination is the Social Security (Class of Visas—Newly Arrived Resident's Waiting Period for Special Benefit) Determination 2011.

2. Commencement

This Determination commences on 1 January 2012.

3. Class of visas

For the purposes of paragraph 739A(8)(c) of the *Social Security Act 1991* the classes of visas are:

- (i) Subclass 309 Partner (Provisional);
- (ii) Subclass 309 Spouse (Provisional);
- (iii) Subclass 310 Interdependency (Provisional);
- (iv) Subclass 820 (Partner Temporary);
- (v) Subclass 820 (Spouse Temporary); and
- (vi) Subclass 826 Interdependency (Provisional).
