Northern Prawn Fishery (Closures) Direction No. 159

Overview of the Bill/Legislative Instrument

Northern Prawn Fishery (Closures) Direction No. 159 (the Direction) closes areas of the fishery to fishing while allowing for night time fishing in certain areas of the fishery at specified times.

The Direction allows for the targeting of tiger prawns during night time hours and provides for end of season closures.
