#### 1 Name of order

This order is the Export Control (Fees) Amendment Order 2012 (No. 1).

## 14 Imposition of fees

- (1) Fees are imposed in accordance with this Part for the performance of services in respect of the following goods:
  - (a) grains (whether prescribed grains or not);
  - (b) plants;
  - (c) plant products.
- (2) A fee imposed in accordance with this Part is payable by the person for whom the services are performed.

#### 15 Inspection services

(1) The fee for an inspection service is \$36 for each quarter hour.

Examples

- 1 Inspecting goods.
- 2 Booking inspection services.
- 3 Providing reports and information.
- 4 Conducting an audit.
- (2) However:
  - (a) the maximum amount of the fee for a day (not including overtime) is \$1 152; and
  - (b) the maximum amount of the fee for a week (not including overtime) is \$5,760.
