### 1 Name of Determination

This Determination is the *Aged Care (Residential Care Subsidy – Amount of Oxygen Supplement) Determination 2012 (No. 1).* 

### 2 Commencement

This Determination commences on 1 July 2012.

## 3 Revocation

The Aged Care (Residential Care Subsidy — Amount of Oxygen Supplement) Determination 2011 (No. 1) made by the Minister on 17 June 2011, also known as F2011L01210, is revoked.

# 4 Amount of Oxygen Supplement

- (1) Subject to subsection (2), the amount of oxygen supplement payable in respect of a day is \$10.35.
- (2) Where the actual cost to the approved provider of administering oxygen to the care recipient is equal to, or more than, 125% of the amount referred to in subsection (1) (i.e. \$12.94), the amount of the oxygen supplement payable in respect of a day is an amount equivalent to that actual cost.
