**1 Name of regulation**

This regulation is the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Administration) Amendment Regulation 2012 (No. 1)*.

**2 Commencement**

This regulation commences on the day after it is registered.

**3 Amendment of *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Administration) Regulations 1995***
