1 Name of Determination

This Determination is the *Health Insurance (Professional Services Review - Allied Health and Others) Determination 2012.*

2 Commencement

This Determination commences on 1 January 2013.

4 Health Practitioners

For the purposes of subsection 81(1A)(a) of the Act, a health professional listed in Part A of Schedule 1 is a "practitioner".

5 Professions

For the purposes of subsection 81(1A)(b) of the Act, a vocation engaged in by a health professional of a kind listed in Part B of Schedule 1 is a "profession".
