

Superannuation (PSSAP) (Australian Government Superannuation Scheme Member) Declaration 2013 (No. 1)¹

Superannuation Act 2005

I, PENELOPE YING YEN WONG, Minister for Finance and Deregulation, make this Declaration under subsection 4 (1) of the *Superannuation Act 2005*.

1 Name of Declaration

This Declaration is the Superannuation (PSSAP) (Australian Government Superannuation Scheme Member) Declaration 2013 (No. 1).

2 Commencement

This Declaration commences immediately after the commencement of clause 4 of the Ninth Amendment of the Superannuation (PSSAP) Trust Deed.

3 Definitions

In this Declaration:

PSS means the *Public Sector Superannuation Scheme*.

4 Persons declared to be Australian government superannuation scheme members

A person who is:

- (a) a member of the PSS; or
- (b) an eligible employee (within the meaning of the *Superannuation Act 1976*);

is declared to be an Australian government superannuation scheme member.

5 Persons declared to be former Australian government superannuation scheme members

A person who is:

- (a) a person who is a former member of the PSS in respect of whom a preserved benefit under PSS has not yet been paid; or
- (b) a person in respect of whom deferred benefits are applicable under the *Superannuation Act 1976*;

is declared to be a former Australian government superannuation scheme member.
