

Aged Care (Community Care Subsidy Amount) Determination 2013 (No. 1)

1 Name of Determination

This Determination is the *Aged Care (Community Care Subsidy Amount)* Determination 2013 (No. 1).

2 Commencement

This Determination commences on 1 July 2013.

3 Revocation

The *Aged Care (Community Care Subsidy Amount) Determination 2012 (No. 1)* made by the Minister on 22 June 2012, also known as F2012L01417, is revoked.

4 Definitions

In this Determination:

ARIA score, in relation to a location, means the score given to that location under the document titled *Viability Funding* — *ARIA scores for locations as at 30 July 1999*, published by the Commonwealth Department of Health and Ageing.

5 Community Care Subsidy

The amount of community care subsidy payable in respect of a day for a care recipient receiving community care is the sum of the following amounts:

- a. The base subsidy is \$37.38; and
- b. the amount in column 3 of the following table that corresponds to the ARIA score for the geographical location at which the care recipient resides:

Col. 1	Col. 2 ARIA score	Col. 3 Additional daily amount of community care subsidy
2	More than 3.51 but less than 4.67	\$4.21
3	More than 4.66 but less than 5.81	\$5.06
4	More than 5.80 but less than 7.45	\$7.08
5	More than 7.44 but less than 9.09	\$8.50
6	More than 9.08 but less than 10.55	\$11.89
7	More than 10.54	\$14.27
