1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Criminal Code (Terrorist Organisation—Jamiat ul-Ansar) Regulation 2013*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after it is registered.

3 Authority

This regulation is made under the *Criminal Code Act 1995*.

4 Schedule(s)

Each instrument that is specified in a Schedule to this instrument is amended or repealed as set out in the applicable items in the Schedule concerned, and any other item in a Schedule to this instrument has effect according to its terms.

5 Definition

In this regulation:

Code means the *Criminal Code*.

6 Terrorist organisation—Jamiat ul-Ansar

- (1) For paragraph (b) of the definition of *terrorist organisation* in subsection 102.1(1) of the Code, the organisation known as Jamiat ul-Ansar is specified.
- (2) Jamiat ul-Ansar is also known by the following names:
 - (a) Al-Faran;
 - (b) Al-Hadid;
 - (c) Al-Hadith;
 - (d) Harakat ul-Ansar;
 - (e) Harakat ul-Mujahideen;
