## **1 Name of regulation**

This regulation is the *Electronic Transactions Amendment (Migration Exemptions) Regulation 2013*.

## **2 Commencement**

This regulation commences on the day after it is registered.

## **3 Authority**

This regulation is made under the *Electronic Transactions Act 1999*.
