1 Name of rule

This rule is the *Australia Council Rule 2013*.

2 Commencement

Each provision of this rule specified in column 1 of the table commences, or is taken to have commenced, in accordance with column 2 of the table. Any other statement in column 2 has effect according to its terms.

1. Sections 1 to 3 and anything in this rule not elsewhere covered by this table	The day after this rule is registered.	
2. Section 4 and Part 2	The later of: (a) the day after this rule is registered; and (b) the day on which section 48 of the <i>Australia Council Act 2013</i> commences. However, the provisions do not commence at all if the event mentioned in paragraph (b) does not occur.
