



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Therapeutic Goods (Medical Devices) Amendment (Auditing Applications) Regulation 2014



1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Therapeutic Goods (Medical Devices) Amendment (Auditing Applications) Regulation 2014.*

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after it is registered.

3 Authority

This regulation is made under the Therapeutic Goods Act 1989.

4 Schedule(s)

Each instrument that is specified in a Schedule to this instrument is amended or repealed as set out in the applicable items in the Schedule concerned, and any other item in a Schedule to this instrument has effect according to its terms.

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Schedule 1—Amendments

Therapeutic Goods (Medical Devices) Regulations 2002

1 Regulation 5.3 (heading)

Repeal the heading, substitute:

5.3 Selecting applications for auditing (Act s 41FH)

2 At the end of regulation 5.3

Add:

(3) For paragraph 41FH(3)(b) of the Act, a period of 60 working days is prescribed in relation to an application mentioned in subregulation 11.1(3) that is made before 1 July 2014.

3 Subregulation 11.1(4)

Omit "Regulation 5.3", substitute "Subregulation 5.3(1)".
