1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Spent and Redundant Instruments Repeal Regulation 2014 (No. 2)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after it is registered.

3 Authority

This regulation is made under the *Legislative Instruments Act* 2003.

4 Guide to this regulation

This regulation repeals legislative instruments that are spent or no longer required, as authorised by section 48E of the *Legislative Instruments Act* 2003.

To assist the reader, the instruments and provisions repealed by this regulation are listed in 4 Schedules.

Schedule 1 deals with solely amending and repealing instruments.

Schedule 2 deals with amending and repealing instruments that contain application, saving or transitional provisions.

Schedule 3 deals with other instruments that are spent or no longer required.

Schedule 4 deals with the repeal of provisions of instruments that are spent or no longer required.

This regulation contains saving provisions that apply to the repeals, in addition to the provision made by section 7 of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901*. That section applies to this regulation because of section 13 of the *Legislative Instruments Act 2003*.

5 Repeal of amending and repealing instruments

- (1) Each instrument mentioned in Schedule 1 is repealed.
- (2) The repeal of an instrument by this section does not affect any amendment or repeal (however described) made by the instrument.
- (3) Subsection (2) does not limit the effect of section 7 of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901* as it applies to the repeal of an instrument by this section.

6 Repeal of amending and repealing instruments containing other provisions

- (1) Each instrument mentioned in Schedule 2 is repealed.
- (2) The repeal of an instrument by this section does not affect:
 - (a) any amendment or repeal (however described) made by the instrument; or
 - (b) the continuing operation of any provision of the instrument made or expressed to be made for an application, saving or transitional purpose (or that makes provision consequential on or related to such a provision).
- (3) Subsection (2) does not limit the effect of section 7 of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901* as it applies to the repeal of an instrument by this section.

7 Repeal of other redundant instruments

- (1) Each instrument mentioned in Schedule 3 is repealed.
- (2) The repeal of an instrument by this section does not affect:
 - (a) any amendment or repeal (however described) made by the instrument; or
 - (b) the continuing operation of any provision of the instrument made or expressed to be made for an application, saving or transitional purpose (or that makes provision consequential on or related to such a provision).

(3) Subsection (2) does not limit the effect of section 7 of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901* as it applies to the repeal of an instrument by this section.

8 Repeal of provisions of instruments

- (1) Each provision of an instrument that is specified in Schedule 4 is repealed as set out in the applicable items in that Schedule.
- (2) The repeal of a provision of an instrument by this section does not affect:
 - (a) any amendment or repeal (however described) made by the provision; or
 - (b) the continuing operation of the provision to the extent that it is made or expressed to be made for an application, saving or transitional purpose (or it makes provision consequential on or related to a provision made for such a purpose).
- (3) Subsection (2) does not limit the effect of section 7 of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901* as it applies to the repeal of a provision of an instrument by this section.

9 Repeal of this regulation

This regulation is repealed on the day after it commences.

Schedule 1—Repeals of amending and repealing instruments

Guide to this Schedule

This Schedule repeals amending and repealing legislative instruments that are spent, and that would have been repealed automatically under section 48A of the *Legislative Instruments Act* 2003 if they had been made after the commencement of that section.
