

**Australian Securities and Investments Commission
Corporations Act 2001—Paragraphs 601QA(1)(a), 741(1)(a), 926A(2)(c),
951B(1)(a) and 1020F(1)(a)—Amendment**

Enabling Legislation

1. The Australian Securities and Investments Commission makes this instrument under paragraphs 601QA(1)(a), 741(1)(a), 926A(2)(c), 951B(1)(a) and 1020F(1)(a) of the *Corporations Act 2001* (the *Act*).

Title

Commencement
