1 Name of Instrument

- (1) This instrument is the National Health (Pharmaceutical benefits supplied under subsection 93A(4)) (Repeal) Determination 2015.
- (2) This instrument may also be cited as PB 21 of 2015.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 April 2015.

3 Repeal

The National Health (Pharmaceutical benefits supplied under subsection 93A(4)) Determination 2012 (PB 50 of 2012) is repealed.

4 Savings

The National Health (Pharmaceutical benefits supplied under subsection 93A(4)) Determination 2012 (PB 50 of 2012) as in force immediately before 1 April 2015 continues to apply to a medication chart prescription written before 1 April 2017 in accordance with regulations 19 and 19AA of the National Health (Pharmaceutical Benefits) Regulations 1960 (the Regulations) as in force immediately before 1 April 2015 and relying upon regulation 58 of the Regulations.
