- 1. Authority for making the instrument: *Programs and Awards Statute 2013,* section 8.

Purpose and operation of the instrument: The Rule describes the circumstances under which students enrolled in coursework award programs might be refused re-enrolment in a course or courses, or might be excluded from further coursework study. The Rule also establish procedures under which students may appeal against such decisions.

- 4. Consultation process: The Rule was made by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendation of the Academic Board.
