1 Name

This is the *Legislative Instruments (Fuel Standards Instruments) Sunset-altering Declaration 2016*.

2 Commencement

This instrument is made under subsection 51A(1) of the *Legislative Instruments Act 2003*.

4 Repeal of fuel standards instruments to facilitate review etc.

- (1) Each of the following instruments is repealed on 1 October 2019:
- the *Fuel Quality Information Standard (Ethanol) Determination 2003*;
 - the *Fuel Quality Information Standard (Ethanol E85) Determination 2012*;
 - the *Fuel Quality Standards (Register of Prohibited Fuel Additives) Guidelines 2003*;
 - the *Fuel Standard (Autogas) Determination 2003*;
 - the *Fuel Standard (Automotive Diesel) Determination 2001*;
 - the *Fuel Standard (Biodiesel) Determination 2003*;
 - the *Fuel Standard (Ethanol E85) Determination 2012*;
 - the *Fuel Standard (Petrol) Determination 2001*.
- (2) The instruments mentioned in subsection (1):
- would, apart from this declaration, be repealed by section 50 of the *Legislative Instruments Act 2003*; and
 - will be the subject of a single review.
- (3) The making of this declaration will facilitate the undertaking of the review of the instruments and the implementation of its findings.

5 Repeal of this instrument

This instrument is repealed on 2 October 2019.
