1 Name

5 Terrorist organisation—Jamiat ul-Ansar

- (1) For the purposes of paragraph (b) of the definition of **terrorist organisation** in subsection 102.1(1) of the *Criminal Code*, the organisation known as Jamiat ul-Ansar is specified.
- (2) Jamiat ul-Ansar is also known by the following names:
- (a) Al-Faran;
 - (b) Al-Hadid;
 - (c) Al-Hadith;
 - (d) Harakat ul-Ansar;
 - (e) Harakat ul-Mujahideen;
 - (f) Harakat ul-Mujahidin;
 - (g) HuM;
 - (h) JuA.
