Each of the following human diseases is a listed human disease:

- (a) human influenza with pandemic potential;
- (b) Middle East respiratory syndrome;
- (c) plague;
- (d) severe acute respiratory syndrome (SARS);
- (e) smallpox;
- (f) viral haemorrhagic fevers;
- (g) yellow fever.
