CIRCUMSTANCES IN WHICH A PAYPAL SURCHARGE MUST BE WAIVED OR REFUNDED 2016/084

(Regulation 5.41B)

- I, *PETER DUTTON*, Minister for Immigration and Border Protection, acting under subregulation 5.41B(4) of the *Migration Regulations* 1994 (the Regulations):
- 1. SPECIFY the following circumstances for paragraph 5.41B(4)(a):
 - a. where a PayPal surcharge is levied against payment made using local currency when clients make a PayPal payment in Singapore and New Zealand; and
- 2. SPECIFY the following circumstances for paragraph 5.41B(4)(c):
 - a. where a PayPal surcharge is accepted against payment made using local currency when clients make a PayPal payment in Singapore and New Zealand.

This Instrument, Circumstances in which a PayPal surcharge must be waived or refunded 2016/084, IMMI 16/084, commences immediately after the commencement of Schedule 2 to the *Migration Legislation Amendment (2016 Measures No. 3) Regulation 2016.*
