

Determination 2017/03:

Remuneration and Allowances for Holders of Public Office and Judicial and Related Offices

- (i) Pursuant to subsections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid to certain holders of public office, and other matters significantly related thereto, and determines as set out below.

PART 1 - FULL-TIME OFFICES

- **1.1** In this part, Determination Number 19 of 2016 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 The Additional Clauses to Table A2 of the Principal Determination are amended by inserting the following at Clause 2.2.10: "Solicitor-General: While Dr Stephen Donaghue QC does not establish his principal place of residence in Canberra he will be paid an annualised amount of \$34,500 per year instead of the daily amounts of travel allowance set out in Clauses 3.5 3.9 of Determination 2016/07 Official Travel by Office Holders (or any determination that supersedes 2016/07) that would otherwise be payable for travel to Canberra, effective from 2 April 2017".
