1 Name

This Instrument is the *Independent Parliamentary Expenses Authority* (President of the Remuneration Tribunal Fees and Allowances) Rule 2017

2 Commencement

This Instrument commences on 1 July 2017.

3 Definitions

In this instrument:

Act means the Independent Parliamentary Expenses Authority Act 2017.

President has the same meaning as in the *Remuneration Tribunal Act* 1973.

4 Fees

For subsection 19(4) of the Act, no fee is prescribed.

5 Allowances

For subsection 19(4) of the Act, the prescribed allowances are as prescribed from time to time for the purposes of section 12 of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.

Note: Section 12 of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973* requires that a member of the Tribunal shall be paid the fees and allowances as are prescribed. These fees and allowances are prescribed by regulation.
