### 1 Name

This instrument is the *Migration (IMMI 17/079: Repeal of Tests, Scores, Period, Level of Salary and Exemptions to the English Language Requirement for Subclass 457 (Temporary Work (Skilled)) Visas 2015 (IMMI 15/028)) Instrument 2017*. This instrument may also be cited as IMMI 17/079.
