1 Name

4 Repeal of ACT self-government instruments to facilitate review etc.

- (1) The following instruments are repealed by subsection 51A(1) of the *Legislation Act 2003* on 1 April 2020:
- the A.C.T. Self-Government (Consequential Provisions) Regulations;
 - the Australian Capital Territory (Planning and Land Management) Regulations;
 - the *Australian Capital Territory (Self-Government) Regulations 1989*;
 - the *National Land Ordinance 1989* (ACT);
 - the *National Memorials Ordinance 1928* (ACT);
 - the *Reserved Laws (Administration) Ordinance 1989* (ACT);
 - the *Reserved Laws (Interpretation) Ordinance 1989* (ACT);
 - the Seat of Government (Administration) Regulations.
- (2) Those instruments:
- would, apart from this instrument, be repealed by section 50 of the *Legislation Act 2003*; and
 - are or will be the subject of a single review.
- (3) The making of this instrument will facilitate the undertaking of the review of those instruments and the implementation of its findings.
