1 Name of Instrument

(1) This instrument is the *National Health (Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme- class of pharmaceutical items – Subsection 99ACA(3) Determination 2017*.

(2) This instrument may also be cited as PB 82 of 2017.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the date of registration on the Federal Register of Legislation.

3 Revocation

The *Determination under subsection 99ACA(3) of the National Health Act 1953* (PB 59 of 2007) is revoked.

4 Authority

This Determination is made under subsection 99ACA (3) of the *National Health Act 1953*.

5 Definitions

In this Determination:

Administrative price reduction means a non-statutory price reduction that has been agreed under section 85AD of the Act.

Note: Terms used in this Determination have the same meaning as in the Act – see section 13 of the *Legislation Act 2003*. These terms include:

- pharmaceutical item
- listed component drug
- manner of administration

6 Class of pharmaceutical items

The class of pharmaceutical items identified in the Schedule, by listed component drug and manner of administration, have taken a 12.5% administrative price reduction.
