## Schedule 1—Amendments

### *Extradition (Commonwealth countries) Regulations 2010*

#### **1 Schedule 1**

Omit “India”.

### *Extradition (Physical Protection of Nuclear Material) Regulations 1988*

#### **2 Regulation 2**

Insert:

*Physical Protection Convention* has the same meaning as in the *Nuclear Non-Proliferation (Safeguards) Act 1987*.

#### **3 Regulation 2 (definition of the *Physical Protection Convention*)**

Repeal the definition.

### *Extradition Regulations 1988*

#### **4 Regulation 2**

Insert:

*Physical Protection Convention* has the same meaning as in the *Nuclear Non-Proliferation (Safeguards) Act 1987*.

#### **5 Paragraph 2B(1)(h)**

Repeal the paragraph, substitute:

(h) Article 7 of the Physical Protection Convention.
