8 Information Commissioner's annual report—giving information

For the purposes of paragraph 93(3)(a) of the Act, the information must be given:

- (a) if guidelines under section 93A of the Act refer to information being given on a quarterly basis—before the end of 21 days after each quarter ending on 31 March, 30 June, 30 September or 31 December; and
- (b) if guidelines under section 93A of the Act refer to information being given on an annual basis—before the end of 31 July after each financial year.
