

# Privacy (Credit Reporting) Code 2014 (Version 2)—variation approval

Decision and reasons for decision of

## Decision on variation under s26T of the *Privacy Act 1988*

1. In accordance with s 26T(1) of the *Privacy Act 1988* (Privacy Act), I approve the *Privacy (Credit Reporting) Code 2014 (Version 2)*, which varies the registered *Privacy (Credit Reporting) Code 2014 (Version 1.2)* (CR Code V1.2).
2. I direct that, in accordance with s 26T(5) of the Privacy Act, the existing CR Code V1.2 be removed and the *Privacy (Credit Reporting) Code 2014 (Version 2)* (CR Code V2) be included on the Codes Register and registered on the Federal Register of Legislation.
3. In making this decision to vary the registered CR Code V1.2, I have taken into account the requirements for variation of the registered CR Code set out in s 26T of the Privacy Act. I have also considered the matters specified in the *Guidelines for developing codes* issued under s 26V.<sup>1</sup>
4. The CR Code V2 commences on 1 July 2018.
