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### 1 Name of Endorsement

This Endorsement is the Fair Work (State Declarations — employer not to be national system employer) Endorsement 2018 (No.2).

#### 2 Commencement

This Endorsement commences on 1 December 2018.

#### 3 Definition

In this Endorsement: *Act* means the *Fair Work Act 2009*.

#### 4 Endorsement of State Declaration

For paragraph 14(4)(a) of the Act a declaration as in force on 12 October 2018 under the *Industrial Relations Act 1996* (NSW) that an employer mentioned in Schedule 1 is not to be a national system employer for the purposes of the Act, is endorsed.
