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1 Name of Endorsement

2 Commencement

This Endorsement commences on 1 December 2018.

3 Definition

In this Endorsement:

Act means the *Fair Work Act 2009*.

4 Endorsement of State Declaration

For paragraph 14(4)(a) of the Act a declaration as in force on 12 October 2018 under the *Industrial Relations Act 1996* (NSW) that an employer mentioned in Schedule 1 is not to be a national system employer for the purposes of the Act, is endorsed.
