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1 Name

This instrument is the *Electoral and Referendum Amendment (Modernisation) Regulations 2019.*

2 Commencement

For the purposes of paragraph 392(2)(b) of the Act, Form E in Schedule 3 to this instrument is to be used in place of Form E in Schedule 1 to the Act.

Repeal the Schedule, substitute:
