This instrument is the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation (Non-warlike Service) Determination 2019.*

#### 3 Authority

This instrument is made under paragraph 6(1)(b) of the *Military Rehabilitation* and Compensation Act 2004.

#### 4 Schedule 2

Each instrument that is specified in Schedule 2 to this instrument is amended or repealed as set out in the applicable items in that Schedule, and any other item in that Schedule has effect according to its terms.

#### 5 Definitions

In this instrument:

Act means the Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004.

**ADF** means the Australian Defence Force (within the meaning of the *Defence Act 1903*).

**NATO** means the North Atlantic Treaty Organization.

#### 6 Non-warlike service

Schedule 1 specifies service with the Defence Force that is non-warlike service for the purposes of the Act.

#### 1 Non-warlike service

For the purposes of paragraph 6(1)(b) of the Act, service with the Defence Force in an operation mentioned in an item of the following table is non-warlike service if the service:

- (a) is in an area of operation mentioned in the item; and
- (b) occurs during the period mentioned in the item in relation to that area of operation.
