



1 Name

This instrument is the *Legislation (Telecommunications Instruments) Sunset-altering Declaration 2019.*

2 Commencement

The following instruments are repealed by section 51A of the *Legislation Act* 2003 on 1 April 2021:

- (a) Premium Service Determination 2004 (No. 1);
- (b) Spam Regulations 2004;
- (c) Telecommunications Regulations 2001;
- (d) Telecommunications Service Provider (Mobile Premium Services) Determination 2010 (No. 1);
- (e) Telecommunications Service Provider (Mobile Premium Services) Determination 2010 (No. 2).

5 Repeal of this instrument

This instrument is repealed at the start of 2 April 2021.
