3 Authority

This instrument is made under paragraph 51(1)(c) of the *Legislation Act 2003*.

4 Deferral of sunseting

The following instruments, for which the sunseting day is 1 April 2020, are repealed by section 51 of the *Legislation Act 2003* on 1 April 2022:

- (a) the A.C.T. Self-Government (Consequential Provisions) Regulations;
- (b) the Australian Capital Territory (Planning and Land Management) Regulations;
- (c) the *Australian Capital Territory (Self-Government) Regulations 1989*;
- (d) the *National Land Ordinance 1989*;
- (e) the *National Memorials Ordinance 1928*;
- (f) the *Reserved Laws (Administration) Ordinance 1989*;
- (g) the *Reserved Laws (Interpretation) Ordinance 1989*.

Note: The *Legislation (ACT Self-Government Instruments) Sunset-altering Declaration 2017* declared the sunseting day of 1 April 2020 for the above instruments.

5 Repeal of this instrument

This instrument is repealed at the start of 2 April 2022.
