1 Name

- (1) This instrument is the Migration (LIN 19/210: Pool and Pass Marks for General Skilled Migration Visas) Instrument 2019.

5 Definitions

In this instrument:

Act means the Migration Act 1958.

invitation, in relation to an application for a class of visa, means an invitation by the Minister to apply for that class of visa.

6 Pool and pass marks—applications made on or after 16 November 2019

(1) This section applies in relation to a class of visas to which both of the following paragraphs apply:

- (a) the visas are of any of the following subclasses:
 - (i) Subclass 189 (Skilled—Independent) visa;
 - (ii) Subclass 190 (Skilled—Nominated) visa;
 - (iii) Subclass 491 (Skilled Work Regional (Provisional)) visa;
- (b) the applications for the visas are made on or after 16 November 2019.
- (2) For the purposes of the Act and the regulations:
 - (a) the pool mark in relation to the class of visas; and
 - (b) the pass mark in relation to the applications; is 65 points.

7 Pool and pass marks—applications made before 16 November 2019

- (1) This section applies in relation to a class of visas to which all of the following paragraphs apply:
 - (a) the visas are of a subclass mentioned in column 1 of an item of the table in subsection (3);
 - (b) the requirements specified in column 2 of the item are met;
 - (c) the applications for the visas were made before 16 November 2019.
- (2) For the purposes of the Act and the regulations:
 - (a) the pool mark in relation to the class of visas; and
 - (b) the pass mark in relation to the applications; is the mark specified in column 3 of the item.
