Financial Framework (Supplementary Powers) Regulations 1997

1 In the appropriate position in Part 4 of Schedule 1AB (table)

Insert:

393 Support to communities affected by bushfires payments for children To provide, as child endowment or family allowances within the meaning of paragraph 51(xxiiiA) of the Constitution, one-off payments in relation to bushfires to:

- (a) persons who are eligible, in relation to the bushfires, for an amount of Australian Government Disaster Recovery Payment under the *Social Security Act 1991* that includes the child rate; and
- (b) citizens of New Zealand who hold special category visas and who are eligible, in relation to the bushfires, for Commonwealth ex-gratia assistance that includes an amount in respect of a child or children.
