Part 1—Preliminary

1 Name

- (1) This instrument is the Migration (LIN 20/051: Arrangements for certain Business Skills visas) Instrument 2020.
- (2) This instrument may be cited as LIN 20/051.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 29 February 2020.

3 Authority

This instrument is made under subregulation 2.07(5) of the Regulations.

4 Definitions

In this instrument:

Department means Department of Home Affairs.

visa item means an item of Schedule 1 to the Regulations.

Regulations means the Migration Regulations 1994.

- (2) The instrument that is specified in Schedule 2 is repealed as set out in the applicable item in that Schedule.
