## 1 Name

This instrument is the *Australian Crime Commission Establishment Regulations 2020*.

## 2 Commencement

- (1) Each provision of this instrument specified in column 1 of the table commences, or is taken to have commenced, in accordance with column 2 of the table. Any other statement in column 2 has effect according to its terms.

## 3 Authority

This instrument is made under item 326 of Schedule 1 to the *Australian Crime Commission Establishment Act 2002*.

## 4 Schedules

Each instrument that is specified in a Schedule to this instrument is amended or repealed as set out in the applicable items in the Schedule concerned, and any other item in a Schedule to this instrument has effect according to its terms.

## 5 Definitions

In this instrument:

**CEO** has the meaning given by the *Australian Crime Commission Act 2002*.

**NCA Act** has the meaning given by item 308 of Schedule 1 to the *Australian Crime Commission Establishment Act 2002*.

## 6 Non-publication directions

- (1) This section applies to a direction that:
- was given under subsection 25(9) or 25A(12) of the NCA Act; and
  - was in force immediately before the commencement of this section.
- (2) Subject to subsection (3), the CEO may, in writing, vary or revoke the direction.

- (3) The CEO must not vary or revoke the direction if to do so might prejudice:
  - (a) the safety or reputation of a person; or
  - (b) the fair trial of a person who has been or may be charged with an offence.
